Technical Description:

The FRM70 is exceptionally versatile and can slash anything from grass to substantial bush including young trees. It can even reduce small stumps to ground level.

As you cut, the hinged front intake door lifts and allows the material to enter the blade area for directional felling, without the need to lift the unit off the ground. This is an important safety feature which drastically reduces material thrown clear of the machine.

Heavy-duty rotary cutter built to handle extreme brush cutting jobs. A reinforced front push bar enables the operator to push over trees and cut brush up to 150 mm in diameter. Hinged front intake door. Chains fitted all round. built to fit any skid steer loader running 80 to 170 l/min. The 10 mm steel deck sides are reinforced and set on replaceable steel skid shoes.
